## Authority Touts '17 Triumphs, Sets Goals for Upcoming Year

### Completed Odor Control Project

- The finished project will minimize any future odors from the Wastewater Treatment Plant operations
- Will allow operators to optimize sludge process to reduce volume of sludge to be removed (i.e. long-term savings opportunity) through enhanced biological operations rather than operating in a manner to minimize odors from facility

### Purchased West Conshohocken Sanitary Sewer System

- Allows for previously reserved capacity to be utilized to service future development, which will result in more potential customers to pay for the operational costs of the Wastewater Treatment Plant

- Capital budget - \$2,500,000
- Low bid - 2017 contract \$2,224,400
- Low bid - 2010 contract \$2,284,750
- Escalated 2010 contract price \$2,684,581.25
- \$250,000.00 savings compared to amount budgeted

### Local Share Account Grant

Awarded \$200,000 grant for odor control project

### PA Small Water and Sewer Grant Award

- Awarded \$404,750.00 grant for liner project

- Fourth-highest award in the state (over 600 applications)
- Funds majority of the capital budgeted liner project
