Completed Odor Control Project

• The finished project will minimize any future odors from the Wastewater **Treatment Plant operations**

 Will allow operators to optimize sludge process to reduce volume of sludge to be removed (i.e. long-term savings opportunity) through enhanced biological operations rather than operating in a manner to minimize odors from facility

Purchased West Conshohocken Sanitary Sewer System

 Allows for previously reserved capacity to be utilized to service future development, which will result in more potential customers to pay for the operational costs of the Wastewater Treatment Plant
